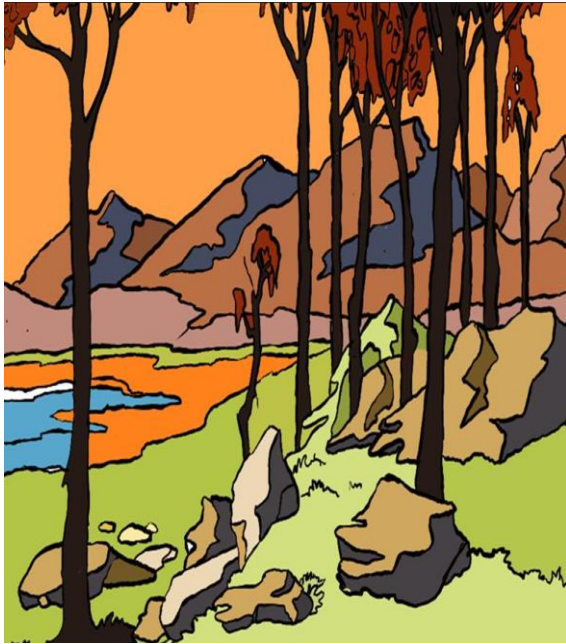


The Glittering Castle

Trench Warfare World War One

In World War I, there was something called trench warfare. A warfare engagement in or the activities involved in war or conflict. A trench is a long, narrow hole, not that deep but about 8 feet deep and 4 to 6 feet wide—the trench warfare dominated World War I. The trenches were a great defensive tactic that both allied and central powers used. The trenches protected the soldiers and hampered enemy troops from advancing, making the war much longer.

There was much technology used in World War I. One of them was the machine gun capable of bringing down row after row of soldiers from a distance on the battlefield. The barbed wire also makes crossing the field even more dangerous with the shooting and bombs. The most impressive tech in World War One was the telephone. The telephone made communication much easier passing information knowing the statics of other station. The telephone was a modern communication solution, but there are modern problems with modern solutions. The telephones were connected with wires, and the wires were being cut in the middle of the battlefield. It needed a soldier to go out on the battlefield, find the cut, fix it, and come back. However, thankfully it was no longer needed in the war when the radio was invented.

In World War I, tactics and strategies were used, such as trench warfare and artillery barrage. The Artillery barrage used short bursts to kill as many soldiers as possible, bringing the soldiers' morale down.

Going back to the trenches, most trench systems had 2, 3, or 4 trench lines parallel to 1.6 km in depth. They dug zigzag pathways so few enemy soldiers could get in them and shoot about a few yards. Each line of the trenches connected to the rear lines of the trenches, where you could find food, ammunition, fresh troops, and mail. There was an area between a trench, and the enemy trench called *No Man's Land*. No man's land was like a land filled with traps. There were landmines and barbed fire wires everywhere. Barbed wires were primarily found in front of the first line trenches covering places where enemy troops may get in.

The war was awfully long, and soldiers created their lifestyle in the trenches. Life in the trenches had much boredom with moments of horror and dread. Soldiers had to wake up before sunrise and then have their breakfast. After that, they had to clean their weapons at noon and dinner. Most of them took a nap during their downtime, played cards, or wrote letters to their loved ones. Life in the trenches was not that clean; the soldiers had showers in weeks or even months. Rats romped the trenches. The trenches homed many diseases like influenza, typhoid, trench foot, and fever.

World War I had some great tech strategies that would be remembered for trench warfare. Life in the trenches affected many soldiers; some had mental problems, and others could not go back to everyday life. They killed a lot, but most died from the diseases, sadly. At least they all died serving their country.

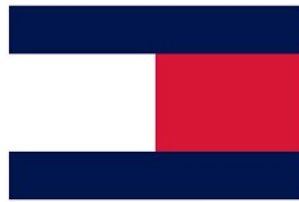
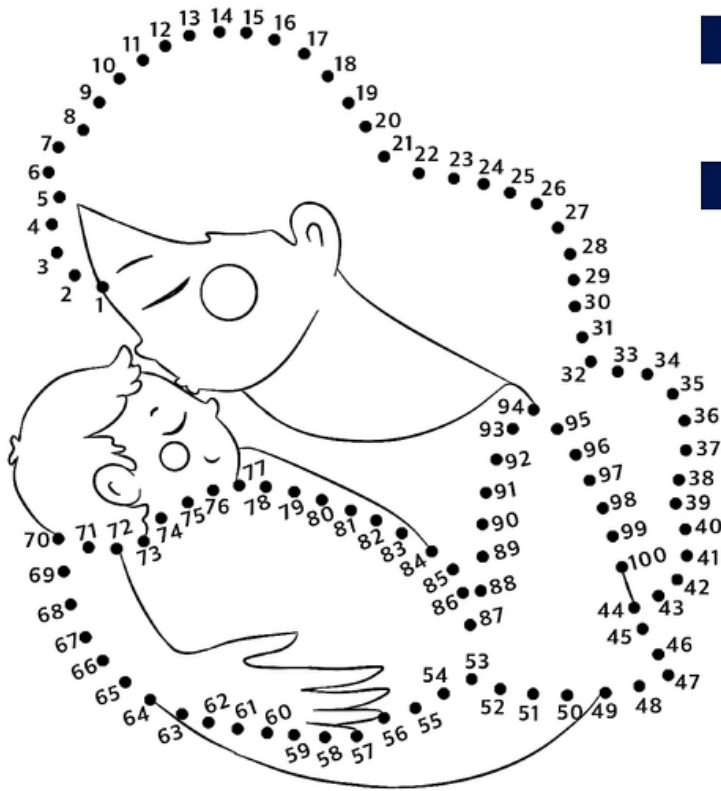
