Writing Matters

Knowing what to write and how to write it are the two aspects of writing. Some students have great ideas but struggle with sentence structure, grammar, and spelling (mechanics of writing) while other students have no trouble with the mechanics of writing but struggle with creative thought. While the mechanics of writing are certainly important, a writer must be able to hook or interest the reader by having something to say that is worth reading.



One way to address these writing concerns is to use a mentor text. Reading and studying the writing of a published author enables students to see how an expert creates character and plot or uses graphics to help explain difficult concepts. Writing in the same style as a mentor writer, often reduces the stress that some students feel when asked to write. Also students are able to take a few steps in the shoes of an author and experience greater success. By first writing like someone else, they are able to find their own writing voice.


At CBS we are using mentor texts or examples of writing to show students what good writing looks like and sounds like. We encourage them to ‘copy’ a style or ‘borrow’ words to help jump start their ideas. To help at home, read to and with your child and talk about how the author was able to draw you into the text; or, how his choice of graphics enabled you to understand the concept. By studying, analyzing, and talking about what good writers do, and what good writing looks and sounds like, we can equip our students with the tools they need to master the ‘what’ and the ‘how’ of writing.





Alligators and Crocodiles



Oceans feel like relaxing and meditation.


