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
SPORTS DAY!

EDITOR'S *Note*

WRITING MATTERS



Earlier this month, our students had the opportunity to listen to and share their stories with an audience. While not all writing needs to be shared in a public forum, it is important that students write for different audiences and for different purposes.

At CBS, we provide students with a wide range of topics and purpose to enable them to persuade, inform, describe and/or entertain their readers. Knowing their audience and purpose helps writers to make informed decisions. Writing a picture book for young children to read on their own requires a different level of language, sentence structure, tone and style than writing an essay on global warming to accompany a science project.

Writing to be shared with an audience requires students to go beyond a first draft. They must reread their work to make certain that the content is accurate, makes sense, and addresses the parameters of the task. Then, they must be willing to add to, delete, or change their content by including transitions, research, illustrations, etc. to clearly articulate their message. Once their ideas are solidified, the task of editing takes place. Editing requires students to rely on their knowledge of the rules of grammar, spelling, paragraph structure and punctuation. To assist students with this task, teachers must provide checklists, anchor charts, explicit instruction, and one-on-one assistance. When students are satisfied with their efforts, they submit their writing for a final review by the teacher. Prior to publishing their work, they may need to address any feedback they receive.


As you can see, creating published work takes both time and effort. For this reason, not all writing is published. Many pieces may sit in a draft stage as forms and formats of writing should be practiced before creating a final or published piece. At CBS, we are working hard to provide opportunities for students to engage in both practicing and publishing their writing. Please encourage your children by asking them to share their writing with you and providing them with both suggestions and encouragement.

Past Events - Young Author's Day

On March 8th students from JK to Grade 6 participated in Young Author's Day which is designed to celebrate writing. Students were organized into multi-grade 'book' teams with an assigned teacher. Students had the opportunity to sit in the 'author's chair' to share their stories with the group and to receive positive feedback for their efforts. A big thanks to everyone for their support in organizing and implementing this event and congratulations to all of our budding authors.



Going Camping






Start anywhere and collect five numbers by following the paths - no jumping or going back over a path twice!


