

From less than a hundred students in the first year, we have grown to over 600 students. While we care about growing the school, it is more important to us to invest in good resources, employ qualified teachers and more importantly provide an environment for teachers, students and parents to work together for the benefit of their children.



Over the last couple of years, we have spent time refining procedures and systems, and putting in place a strong academic program. The student information management system which we implemented allows us to monitor and track the individual performance of our students.
