Warm greetings to our students, staff and parents! It has been another busy year filled with progress at many levels.

Other important events were the Terry Fox Run and International Week.

There has been a lot of involvement and output from students and teachers in these events besides all the other monthly events in the school calendar. I am pleased to be able to offer a variety of programs which help children to grow in multiple areas besides academics.


