



Learning is a process not limited to schools and colleges; nor does it end with the conclusion of one's academic career.




Joe was officially proven innocent. The


parents were devastated, they couldn't comprehend what was happening. The unfairness was so real at that moment. The system revealed itself to be unjust and corrupt.


