Culture of Giving

The poet Ibn Al-Rumi said, "Generous is not he who gives his gift for praise, even if it is more precious, but generous is he who gives a gift for nothing but good approval."

'Giving' is a wonderful word that carries amongst its letters, beautiful meanings that are only felt by those who love giving without compensation and granting without waiting for any consideration. To give is to love goodness, happiness and charity to others without expecting any materialistic returns. If you have a lot, give some of what you have and if you have a little, then share your feelings, love, devotion and sacrifice. The act of love and giving is a culture that we must teach to our children and students, to inspire them with a culture of sharing even if it is a simple thing. When he reached Madinah, the Messenger came to know about Jabir's marriage and, and then informed Bilal (one of his most trusted and loyal companions) to pay Jabir the price of the Camel, give him extra money and to return his camel to him. These morals, which the Master of the Creation carries, make us keen on the love of giving and good deed for others and enjoying the reward of giving from God.

In conclusion, we remind you that all the good we do is a gift, so your loyalty in your work and your academic achievement are gifts for yourself and your country. Your gift to the needy is a gift, your love of good is a gift, your smile to others is a gift, your contribution to the renaissance of your nation is a gift and helping the needy is a gift. Let us donate without expecting return and establish the value of giving in the hearts of our children.
